Now, with all of the social media available to gardeners, there is an entirely new way to share our gardens and love of daylilies with the world.

I use a few different social media platforms in a few different ways—some for work and some for pleasure. I've even had/have a gardening blog that sadly hasn't been updated in close to 2 years. (Can you even say you "have" a blog if you haven't written anything in that long?). I like my social media easy to use and easy to update. After all, like probably everyone reading this, I'm busy. I have a child, a spouse, a full-time job, more pets than are socially acceptable, a large garden, and a small-ish daylily obsession...well, it's smaller than some other people I know.

My favorite platform for sharing my garden is **Instagram**. Just in case you aren't familiar with this social media platform, I'll give you a quick rundown of it. This visual platform allows its users to create an account and upload their pictures. Adding captions and hashtags to help categorize each entry. A hashtag is a descriptive word or phrase that has a "#" in front of it. For example, #daylily, #daylilylove, and #daylilycollector are three hashtags I use a lot.

Once you've created your account, you can follow other users. All of your followers' photos are posted on your home screen so that you can scroll through them. You can also follow specific hashtags. This is my favorite part of **Instagram.** It really lets you focus on what you see based on your particular interests. 
